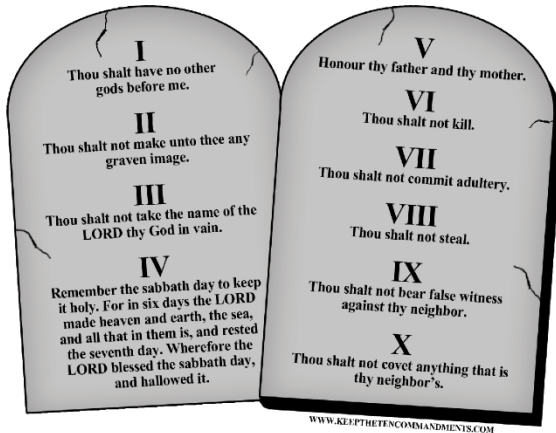

Memorization Guidelines

- 1. Recitation work begins at the ribbon achievement level and works up** (which means the lowest level must be completed before moving on to the next level).
- 2. Memory projects within individual achievement levels can be recited in any order.**
- 3. Memory work must be recited word perfect.**
Our goal is accurate recitation which means recitation without error. However, we ask our listeners to apply wisdom to the task of listening. Push children to their maximum capability and encourage them by recognizing honest effort!
- 4. Individuals that share recitation work with a leader are responsible for completing record slips, obtaining listener signatures and turning the slips in each FDN meeting.**
- 5. Recitation work can be done on Sundays other than designated FDN meetings** (recite work to listeners).
- 5. Recitation credit can only be given at church by leaders** (in the case of children/youth) **or peers** (in the case of adults) **during our Sunday gatherings.**
- 6. Catechism recitations should be done in question & answer format.** The listener will ask question and reciter provides answer.

Heidelberg Catechism Question & Answer One

Q. What is your only comfort in life and in death?

A. That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.

He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.
